GREENSBORO, NC—Area tennis players will gather March 9th at Koury Convention Center to learn about resources available for victims of domestic violence, child abuse, and other issues that affect families and children in their community.

The Guild of Family Service of Greensboro Foundation is teaming up with **Greensboro Country Club** to present the 3rd quadrennial **Love Serving Love** luncheon, an awareness event aimed at educating the Greensboro tennis community about programs of **Family Service of the Piedmont**, the area's largest private non-profit serving children and families in crisis.

“These women share not only a passion for tennis but also for helping women, children and families in their communities,” said **Jennifer Cross Green**, who is co-chair of the event along with fellow Guild member **Amy Kemp**. The volunteers hope the event will inspire members of the tennis community to embrace Family Service’s vision of *building safe and healthy families* in Greensboro.

The program will include speakers from Gate City and USTA tennis leagues, and an auction of local tennis pros for a pro-am tournament on Saturday, March 19th at Starmount Forest Country Club.

The last Love Serving Love luncheon in 2007 was attended by more than 500 members of local tennis clubs. As well as raising consciousness, it also raised \$30,000 to help fund the work of Family Service of the Piedmont in Greensboro.
